From horses to hot rods to cyclists to antique auto clubs to motorcycle groups, all of these have been photographed in front of the white silos at Thompsons's Mills State Heritage Area. Sadly, over the years, the brightness of the logos and the sparkling white on the silos have faded.

Good news! Upgrades of the silos are happening now, and a whitewash is also in the works. Fortunately, the artist who last repainted the original images will once again use her talents to repaint the signage, as well as the logos, this year.



The purpose of this communication is to ask if you would be willing to make a special donation to help with the costs of the painting. One donor has pledged \$250, with an additional \$250 if we attract matching funds for the second \$250.
